

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

For children and young people who have experienced living in alternative care, separated from their biological family, the process of growing up is extremely demanding because they are often left without formal support and a functional social network. They also face many other challenges that independent living brings.

**YOUTH MOVING** is an Erasmus+ project aimed at enhancing care leavers participation in democratic life in Europe, through their empowerment as active citizens, especially addressing how to connect with, express their views and be heard by stakeholders in the alternative care field. The aim will be achieved through two project results:

1. curriculum of workshops aimed at encouraging the participation of young people from alternative care in the democratic processes of society and
2. video material for raising public awareness and policy makers awareness about the importance of participation of young people from alternative care in democratic processes.

## THE AIM AND ACTIVITIES OF THIS PROJECT are focused on:

- strengthening the competencies of people working with youth from alternative care,
- to encourage youth to actively participate in society,
- to overcome limitations and
- to provide opportunities for young people to express their opinion.

## 2ND TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

The 2nd transnational hybrid meeting was hosted by Co&So in Florence, Italy on 12-13 May 2022.

At the meeting Sirius, the project coordinator, and the representatives of CO&SO, FAMO and Forum for quality foster care for children were present in person, while APDES and DGASPC HR joined the meeting online.

During the meeting Sirius presented the progress of the project and together with the partners, they agreed on the division of work regarding O1 and O2.

APDES led the presentation of the consortium's results based on the needs analysis that were done in each partner's country. The Italian partner, Co&So presented the results of the first 6-month project team evaluation, while DGASPC HR, the Romanian team informed the participants about the updated Dissemination plan.
